Day 1: Nairobi to Masai Mara

In the morning at 07:00Hrs, you'll be picked up from your hotel in Nairobi or Jomo Kenyatta International Airport and driven to the Masai Mara National Reserve. The journey from Nairobi to the Masai Mara usually takes around 5-6 hours, depending on road conditions and stops along the way. Upon arrival at the reserve, you'll check in at your safari camp and have some time to relax and enjoy the surroundings. In the afternoon, you'll embark on your first game drive in the Masai Mara. Your experienced safari guide will take you through the park, searching for wildlife such as lions, elephants, giraffes, zebras, and many others. After the game drive, you'll return to your camp for dinner and overnight stay.

Day 2-3: Masai Mara, Kenya

Over the next two days, you'll have ample time to explore the vast plains of the Masai Mara. Embark on morning and afternoon game drives, accompanied by experienced guides who will help you spot the diverse wildlife that calls this reserve home. Keep an eye out for the "Big Five" (elephant, lion, leopard, buffalo, and rhino), as well as cheetahs, giraffes, zebras, wildebeests, and numerous bird species. Witness the dramatic annual wildebeest migration, where millions of wildebeest and other herbivores cross the Mara River in search of fresh grazing lands. Witnessing this natural spectacle can be a highlight of your safari experience.

Day 4: Masai Mara to Western Serengeti, Tanzania

After breakfast, bid farewell to Masai Mara and cross the border into Tanzania. Your destination for the day is the western part of the Serengeti National Park. This area is known for its abundance of wildlife, especially during the migration season. Arrive in the western Serengeti and check-in at your camp. Enjoy a game drive in the afternoon, exploring the open plains and searching for predators such as lions, cheetahs, and hyenas. The western Serengeti is also renowned for its resident hippos and crocodiles along the Grumeti River.

Enjoy a picnic lunch amidst the stunning surroundings of the crater before continuing your game drive in the afternoon.
